We have been doing this since 2008 and this is the first year that someone won all 3 lowest scores and we will change this and make it better for all the ladies. With the really low handicap Canadians not playing with us this year, this happened but it is better this way anyway.
- 2 the lowest net score will be handled the same way. A different golfer for each of the 3 places even if the 1st place winner has 3 or 4 scores that are the lowest net.
- 3 the 3rd change will be handled in the same way but for the lowest putts. 3 different people will win 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for lowest putts of the year even if the 1st place gal has the lowest putts on many different occasions.

This gave more golfers an opportunity to win in our 8 categories. Our categories are:

- 1- Medallion winners, low gross and low net ... 2 winners
- 2- Most Improved Golfer
- 3- Club Gross Average of the year ... 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 4- Club Net Average of the year ... 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 5- Lowest Gross Score CHANGED ... 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 6- Lowest Net Score CHANGED ... 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 7- Lowest Putts CHANGED ... 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 8- The Ringer Awards in 3 flights ... 1st, 1st, 1st
